The ACA Standards Course provides an in-depth overview of the ACA accreditation process. This course provides participants the opportunity to examine and clarify standards that serve as the infrastructure of the ACA Accreditation Program.

Who Should Attend? The course is required for camp administrators with camps new to the accreditation process and for new administrators in currently accredited camps. One or more representatives from the camp are welcome to take the course, and at least one of these individuals must be present at the site on the day of the visit. Camp representatives might include executives, directors, program directors, assistant directors, or other key staff. This course is also a prerequisite for those interested in becoming Associate Visitors.
